

## **Website Privacy Policy**

### **Introduction:**

The website, [www.dregomez.com](http://www.dregomez.com) (“Website” or “We” or “Our” or “Us”), is sensitive to protecting the privacy of the Website visitors (“You” or “Your”). As used in this Policy, personal information does not include information protected under HIPAA or applicable state laws, which is protected as described in the “Health and Medical Information” section above.

We may collect information that does not personally identify You for various purposes (e.g., Website usage, traffic patterns, site performance and related statistics based on Our tracking record of Your visits to the Website).

We may collect some of this information using persistent “cookies” to recognize a repeat visitor in order to collect general information about how the Website is viewed. We may also collect and log the IP address of each visitor to gather aggregate data on visitors to the Website. Please note that neither cookies nor IP addresses are used to collect any personal information from You.
